## EARLYON SCIENCE: WHAT HAPPENS WHEN?

What You Will Need:

- Large container
- Small container
- Vinegar
- Dish soap
- Tongs
- Baking soda
- Warm water
- Food colouring

Directions:

1. Fill a large container 1/2 full of vinegar and add a few drops of dish soap.
2. Fill a small container with baking soda, warm water and food colouring. Put the lid on top and place in the larger container.
3. Use the tongs to remove the cap of the smaller container and watch what happens!

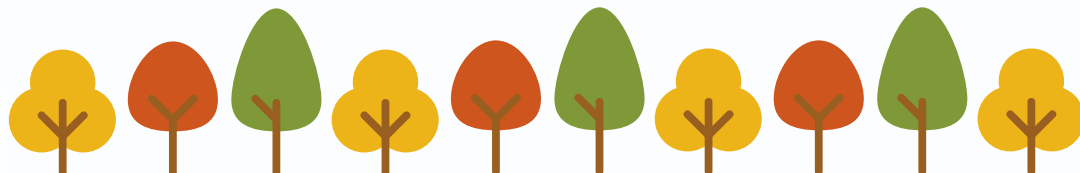

- 1 - 2 times per week, 63,570 words
- 3 - 5 times per week, 169,520 words
- Daily, 296,660 words
- 5 books a day, 1,483,300 words!
